BIDS AND QUOTES

City Manager Mary Ellen Bechtel presented Bid Results for the Woodland Drive Sewer Reroute and the White Oak Sewer Project. City Manager Bechtel explained this is the first project the City has bid out since experiencing price increases of pipe and other materials. The City has the funds to move ahead with the project, as there are budgeted projects that have not been started this year and the sewer capital fund has a strong balance. There were three bidders for this. The low bidder was Haier Plumbing & Heating, Inc. in the amount of \$312,077.00. Staff recommendation is to award the bid to Haier Plumbing & Heating, Inc.
