Mount Vernon, Illinois Community Survey Executive Summary

Overview

ETC Institute administered a community survey for the City of Mount Vernon, Illinois during the winter and spring of 2024. The purpose of the survey was to help determine potential improvements to Veteran's Park and Lincoln Park and need for indoor recreation facility.

Methodology

ETC Institute mailed a survey packet to a random number of households in Mount Vernon area. Each survey packet contained a cover letter, a copy of the survey, and a postage-paid return envelope. Residents who received the survey were given the option of returning the survey by mail or completing it online at <u>MtVernonsurvey.org</u>.

After the surveys were mailed, ETC Institute followed up with residents to encourage participation. To prevent people who were not residents of Mount Vernon from participating, everyone who completed the survey online was required to enter their home address prior to submitting their survey. ETC Institute then matched the addresses entered online with the addresses originally selected for the random sample. If the address from a survey completed online did not match one of the addresses selected for the sample, the online survey was not included in the final database for this report.

The survey aimed to collect a minimum of 300 completed responses from residents, and this target was surpassed with 423 completed surveys collected. The overall results for the sample of 423 residents have a precision of at least +/-4.75% at the 95% level of confidence.

The major findings of the survey are summarized in the following pages.

Parks/Facilities Use

Veteran's Park: Respondents were asked how often they visited Veteran's Park over the past year. 9% visited "more than once a week," 8% visited "once per week," 21% visited "1 to 2 times a month," 44% visited "a few times per week," and 19% "haven't visited the park in the past 12 months." For those that said they "haven't visited the park in the past 12 months," they gave barriers that prevented them from visiting the park more often. The barriers that were highly selected were: do not feel safe using the park (31%), lack of amenities we want to use (25%), and too busy/not interested (23%). They also rated their level of support for the additions/improvements that could be made at Veteran's Park. The additions/improvements that respondents supported the most were: improve existing restrooms (81%), add amenities along walking trail (i.e., benches, drinking fountains, exercise stations) (80%), and Pond beautification improvements (i.e., lake edge planting, decorative boulders, fishing dock) (78%). Then, they selected additions/improvements that were most important to them. The additions/improvements that were highly selected were: add amenities along walking trail (44%), extend walking/biking trail (34%), and Pond beautification improvements (33%).

Rolland Lewis Community Building: Respondents were asked if they attended an event at the Rolland Lewis Community Building in Veteran's Park in the past year. 54% responded "yes." Ten percent (10%) indicated that they rented the facility for their own event.

Lincoln Park: Respondents were asked how often they visited Lincoln park in the past year. 4% visited "more than once a week," 3% visited "once per week," 6% visited "1 to 2 times a month," 19% visited "a few times per year," and 68% "haven't visited the park in the past 12 months," they gave barriers that prevented them from visiting Lincoln park more often. The barriers that were highly selected were: too busy/not interested (25%), lack of amenities we want to use (25%), and use other parks/facilities (18%). They also rated their level of support for the additions/improvements that could be made at Lincoln park. The additions/improvements that respondents supported the most were: add picnic shelters/areas (67%), add restrooms (67%), and extend walking/biking trail (62%). Then, they selected the additions/improvements that are most important to them. The additions/improvements that were highly selected were: add picnic shelters/areas (31%), add restrooms (30%), and extend walking/biking trail (28%).

Aquatic Zoo Water Park: Respondents were asked how often they visited the Aquatic Zoo Water Park in the past year. 2% visited "more than once a week," 3% visited "once per week," 7% visited "1 to 2 times a month," 28% visited "a few times per year," and 60% "haven't visited the park in the past 12 months." For those that "haven't visited the park in the past 12 months," they gave barriers that prevented them from visiting the park more often. The barriers that were highly selected include: too busy/not interested (39%), lack of shade (18%), and lack of amenities we want to use (10%).

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Indoor Recreation Facilities in Other Communities: Respondents were asked how far they travel to use indoor recreation facilities in other communities. 7% travels "10 to 15 miles," 2% travels "15 to 20 miles," 12% travels "20 to 30 miles," 19% travels "30+ miles," and 59% said "we don't travel to other communities for indoor recreation." Then, they were asked how often they visited indoor recreation facilities in other communities in the past year. 3% visited "more than once a week," 3% visited "once per week," 8% visited "1 to 2 times a month," 28% visited "a few times per week," and 58% visited "haven't visited the park in past 12 months." They also gave their preferred method of payment for use of a new indoor recreation facility (if one were to be developed). 28% preferred "daily admission fees," 16% preferred "10-punch admission pass," 38% preferred "monthly membership," and 18% preferred "annual membership."

Benefits, Importance, and Improvements to Parks and Recreation

Plans for a New Indoor Recreation Facility: The city wants to explore the importance of a new indoor recreation facility that would meet the needs of the community. Respondents were asked to select the features that they would like to see in the new indoor recreation facility. The features that were selected the most were: indoor running/walking track (82%), lap lanes for swim lessons, exercise swimming, competitive swimming or therapeutic purposes (74%), and aerobics/fitness/gymnastics space (73%). Then, they selected the features they would be most likely to use if they were included in the new indoor recreation facility. The features that were highly selected were: indoor running/waling track (46%), lap lanes for swim lessons, exercise swimming, competitive swimming or therapeutic purposes (33%), and aerobics/fitness/gymnastic space (30%).

Additional Findings

Resident/Non-Resident Fees: Respondents were asked if they believe that Mt. Vernon resident fees should be lower than non-resident fees. 88% responded "yes."





Q1. Including yourself, how many people in your household are...






Q2. How often have you/your household visited Veteran's Park over the past year?






Q4. Please indicate your level of support for the following additions/improvements.




Q5. Which four potential additions/improvements are most important to your household?


by percentage of respondents who selected the items as one of their top four choices




Q6. Have you/your household attended an event at the Rolland Lewis Community Building in Veterans Park in the past year?



Q6a. Did you rent the facility for your own event?




Q8. How often have you/your household visited Lincoln Park in the past year?




Q9. Please check all the reasons that prevent you/your household from visiting Lincoln Park more often.




Q10. Please indicate your level of support for these additions/improvements.




Q11. Which four potential additions/improvements are the most important to your household?

by percentage of respondents who selected the items as one of their top four choices




Q12. How often have you/your household visited the Aquatic Zoo Water Park in the past year?




Q13. Please check all the reasons that prevent you/your household from visiting Aquatic Zoo Water Park more often.

by percentage of respondents (multiple selections could be made)




Q14. How likely would you use these features?

by percentage of respondents (excluding "Not At All Likely")




Q15. Which four of the features would your household be most likely to use if they were included in a new indoor recreation facility?


by percentage of respondents who selected the items as one of their top four choices




Q16. How far do you/your family travel to use indoor recreation facilities in other communities?




Q17. How often have you/your household visited an indoor recreation facility in other communities in the past year?




Q18. If a new indoor recreation facility were developed, what would be your preferred method of payment for use of the facility?



Q19. Do you think that Mt. Vernon resident fees should be lower than non-resident fees?




Q20. Is it important for an indoor recreation center to have a positive economic impact on the community?




Q21. Your gender identity:

by percentage of respondents (excluding "prefer not to disclose")




Q22. How many years have you lived in Mt. Vernon?
